NOTICE INVITING TENDER

The Competition Appellate Tribunal (COMPAT) invites sealed tenders from reputed and experienced firm for "Providing the services of Driver on contractual basis". The contract will be for a period of one year or till a regular incumbent joins or till further orders, whichever is the earliest.

2. The tenderer shall be registered with all the agencies as prescribed under various labour laws and shall have minimum three years' experience in doing similar nature of work and have successfully completed the same. The tenderer must be eligible for providing the services of Driver in Delhi and shall submit the documentary evidence in support thereof along with the bid document.

3. The tender shall be put in a sealed cover and the name of the work "Providing the service of Driver", shall be clearly written on top of the sealed cover. Unsealed tenders shall be summarily rejected.

4. The bids shall be submitted at the Reception Counter, Competition Appellate Tribunal, Kota House Annexe, Shahjahan Road, New Delhi-110011 upto 3.00 p.m. on 09.07.2015.

5. The bids will be opened on the same day at 3.30 p.m. at the same address by the Tender Issuing Authority. The COMPAT reserves the right to cancel the tender.

6. The acceptance of a tender rests with the COMPAT, which does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender and reserves itself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received without assigning any reason. All tenders in whom any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.

7. Canvassing in any form in connection with tender is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.

8. On acceptance of the tender, the name of the accredited representative (s) of the contractor who would be responsible for taking instructions from COMPAT shall be communicated to the COMPAT.

9. It will be obligatory on the part of the tenderer to tender and sign the tender documents on each page.
